Obtain a US passport that does not expire before 9/4/24
Make sure your driver's license (2nd form of ID) does not expire before 3/15/24
Bring US passport and driver's license to Elizabeth Johnson to be photocopied by TBD
Get familiar with your health insurance policy regarding international travel
Inform credit card company of travel plans and intent to use card
Obtain Euros from your bank (worth approximately \$400) for food and souvenirs
Adjust your mobile phone plan if you intend to make/receive calls to/from US
Update Magnus to include all prescription meds to be taken on the trip
Optional: make a personal photocopy of all cards you are taking on the trip

Policy for Families Extending the Trip

- 1. Tickets will be purchased for all students for all parts of the trip
- 2. No reimbursement will be offered for an unused ticket
- 3. Every senior must begin the trip departing from DFW on the same flight
- 4. On the morning of Tuesday, March 12 we will depart from Florence (FLR). A chaperone may hand a student over to the student's mother or father at the Florence airport prior to the group boarding the flight from Florence to Frankfurt. If the parent is not present for a hand off prior to the time of boarding, the student must board the airplane with the group and return all the way to DFW (regardless of any previous plans).
