CORE PROGRAMS *that* CHALLENGE & EQUIP

Gifts to The Covenant Fund are applied in a variety of student-focused areas that improve our ability to deliver on our mission every day, including academics, fine and performing arts, athletics, spiritual formation, events, traditions, and more.

Your Generosity in Action: Addition of Grammar School Nature Studies; K-6th supplies and 5th-8th academic planners; Parent Partnership and Appetite for Learning events; Alumni Relations enhancements, including a 10-year reunion and visits to alumni on four college campuses; acquisition of the St. Peter's Classical School library; investments in technology and databases for the Research Library; new theatre microphones; and acoustic choir shells.

A COMMUNITY *that* CARES & INSPIRES

The Covenant Fund is used to invest in training and professional development so that our teachers, staff, and administrators can pursue lifelong learning, embody virtue, and develop excellence in their respective fields.

Your Generosity in Action: Salary increases for all employees; enhancements to employee benefits, including free Teladoc services for all employees; positions added for Grammar School Science/Nature Studies, Facilities, Summer Camps, Alumni Relations, Mock Trial, Athletics, and Gatehouse; CPR and Ministry Safe training for employees; a variety of professional development opportunities; math training for K-6th teachers; symposium training for Lead Teachers and Department Chairs; summer reading groups for employees; and lunch for all employees during the two weeks before school starts.

A CAMPUS *designed for* LEARNING & GROWING

Gifts are invested in campus and facility updates, repairs, and enhancements so that our community can continue to delight in the beauty of our 50-acre campus.

Your Generosity in Action: Security enhancements, including the new Amber Ridge gatehouse, motorized entry gates, and vehicle stickers; third passenger van in the fleet; irrigation and drainage improvements on Cavalier Football Field; new gym bleachers; addition of parking lot speed bumps; all-terrain vehicle for use by Facilities Team; improved phone and paging system; carpet, paint, and siding in select areas; new projectors for Auditorium and select classrooms; and lighted flagpole and flag.

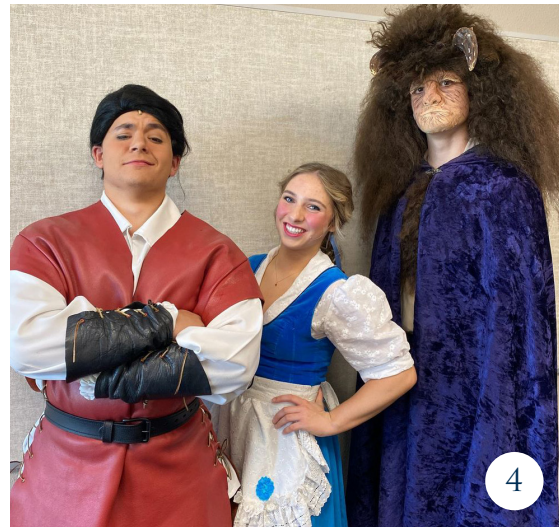
CARE FOR OTHERS *that* IS THERE WHEN NEEDED

Giving keeps our school accessible to a wider range of families by increasing the funds available for tuition assistance, including funds set aside to help families who encounter hardship and are temporarily unable to afford our outstanding programs.

Your Generosity in Action: Last year, 65 students received tuition assistance, 86 students received remission discounts, and \$30,382 was distributed through the Bridge Fund that provides assistance for families encountering temporary hardship.

- 1 A lighted flagpole and flag were added to the center of our campus last spring.
- 2 Entryway security enhancements include our new gatehouse and gatehouse attendant, as well as motorized gates and vehicle stickers to aid in the quick identification of visitors.
- 3 A new Summer Camps Coordinator position was added, along with several new camps. (This one was a hair-raising experience!)
- 4 "Beauty and the Beast" performed to three sold-out audiences with new investments in microphones, makeup, and set design.
- 5 Additional investments in our trail allowed our Cross Country student-athletes to host their inaugural "Cavalier Charge" on campus.

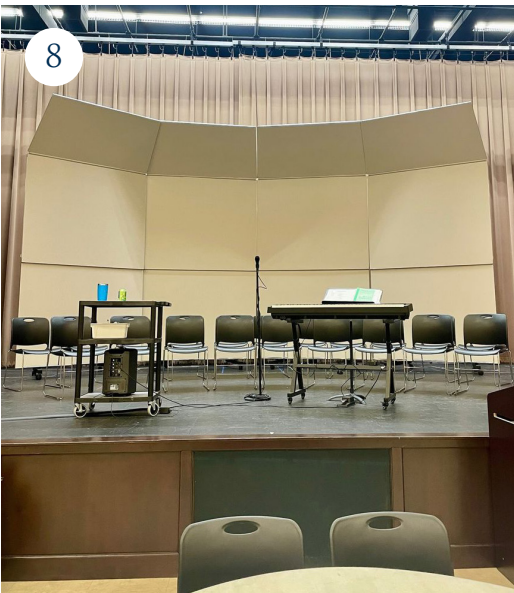

- 6 Alumni Relations programming expanded to include a 10-year reunion, on-campus events, and four visits to in-state college campuses.
- 7 Employees enjoyed a variety of professional development opportunities throughout the year, including attendance at national conferences, on-campus training opportunities, and educational assistance for the pursuit of advanced degrees.
- 8 New choir shells have enhanced the Auditorium's acoustic experience during choir performances and grade-level Grammar School recitations.
- 9 Investments in existing spaces – like this room in the Grammar School Admin Building – have resulted in beautiful gathering spots for grade-level Advisory Groups and on-campus meetings.
- 10 A third passenger van was added to our fleet to assist with extra-curricular transportation needs.
