Rhetoric School

General (for every student):

- Binder(s): students are responsible for keeping their work organized. Each course must have an individual binder or a separated section in a larger binder.
- Loose-leaf notebook paper
- Cornell graph paper for math (also for science in 11–12): available for purchase in the school office for \$5/pack (a pack is 200 sheets)
