Rhetoric School

General (for every student):

- Binder(s): students are responsible for keeping their work organized. Each course must have an individual binder or a separated section in a larger binder.
- Loose-leaf notebook paper
- Cornell graph paper for math (also for science in 11–12): available for purchase in the school office for \$8.50/pack (a pack is 200 sheets)
- Pencils
- Black or blue pens
- Red correcting pencils
- Highlighter(s)
- Access to a computer for writing papers

 - Five tabbed dividers
 - Clear plastic sheet protectors
 - Loose-leaf notebook paper (no spiral notebooks)
- Coloring Pencils
- Three pronged pocket folder (to hold graded assessments)

Rhetoric

- Folder with prongs

Literature

- Binder (1 inch binder will suffice - not shared between subjects)
- Hardcover journal for common placing (at least 5in x 8.5in)
 - Should last entire school year (and beyond)
 - No composition journals
 - No spiral notebooks
